Frank mentioned the audit will take place in March or April and the Auditor will find the issue and fix it. Norman, Frank and Tom talked about different software programs and uses for our needs.

Old Business:

- A. Pelican Park Drainage - The contract is just about completed, just the \$15,000 retainer is all that remains, with a couple of change orders made to be completed. The contractor has done the Bermuda seeding. We will have a turf company come in at the end of March or early April for a second seeding.
- B. Carencro Park: Frank stated LCG and the mayor's office are still working on getting the contract finalized. LCG is asking, Carencro to have \$1 million insurance coverage. Carencro is required by the state to have \$ 1/2 million of liability insurance coverage. LCG needs to amend of liability insurance from \$1 million to a \$ ½ million in coverage and the council

approve the change. It is not necessary for us to reapprove the agreement per City Manager, Don Chauvin.

Lighting at Carencro Park, Tom notified Entergy of security lights and streetlights out on Prejean Road and Tournament Drive at Softball Drive.
