Mayor Glenn L. Brasseaux called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Councilmember Kim Guidry led the Pledge of Allegiance. Following the pledge, the mayor asked for a moment of silence for our military service personnel and their families who have served and for those who continue to serve defending our freedoms.

**DISCUSSION:**

Discuss new police station.

Discuss purchase of land for new police station.

Mayor Brasseaux informed the council and the public that he contacted Mr. Paul Martin about selling his property that is located in front of the new proposed police station. Since Mr. Martin is interested in selling, Mayor Brasseaux had the property appraised.

Mayor Brasseaux recognized Architect Lynn Guidry. Mr. Guidry presented drawings of the layout of the police station to be built on the property which is located south of the library. The first layout showed some restrictions of the building site because of the minimum frontage facing N. University gaining access to the back of the property. The second layout presented if the property is purchased gives little restrictions because of having much more frontage access to the back of the property.

Mr. Guidry informed the council and the public that it would also save roughly \$123,000.00 due to less dirt work, less utility (water/sewer) runs, no need to relocate power poles, Cox lines and other lines that may be involved. The building would be built further south on the property away from the coulee that runs along the north property line by the library.

**INTRODUCTORY ORDINANCES:**

1. Ordinance No. 2022-002: An ordinance of the Carencro City Council authorizing the purchase of certain immovable property needed for a new police station facility.

Mayor Brasseaux called for questions or comments from the council or the public. With no further comments, Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 2022-002; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Councilmember Babineaux made a motion to adjourn; seconded by Councilmember Sinegal; motion approved.
