Mayor Clavier asked for questions or comments from the council or the public regarding the department's monthly reports.

UPDATES:

Fire Station on Gloria Switch- Architect Lynn Guidry updated the council and public stating that the fire station is complete and the one item remaining is getting the generator commissioned.

Police Station- The project is 93% complete. All concrete drives and parking and most of the sidewalks have been poured. All the interior rough in work is complete. The flooring and the acoustical panels are being installed. The project is expected to be completed end of April 2024.

Chief Administrative Updates- Mr. Morrison informed the council and public that the gas grant is finalized and the city has submitted the first reimbursement (RFQ) Request for Qualifications.

Councilmember Babineaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2024-015; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2024-016: Cooperative Endeavor Agreement for Firefighting Services by and between the Parish of Lafayette and City of Carencro.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2024-016; seconded by Councilmember James; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2024-017: Cooperative Endeavor Agreement between the City of Carencro and Carencro C'est Bon Festival, Inc.

Councilmember Babineaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2024-017; seconded by Councilmember James; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2024-018: A resolution of the City of Carencro to support Carencro C'est Bon Festival Seasoning Fest, Inc.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2024-018; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2024-020: A resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the Park and Recreation budget for services to the citizens of Carencro, Louisiana (Restroom Facilities, AED Defibrillators).
