



## Community Development Block Grant Public Facilities Program Improving Our Infrastructure for a Stronger Future



The City of Carencro is applying for funding through the FY 2026–2027 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Public Facilities Program to upgrade two key lift stations—Veterans Drive Lift Station No. 8 and First Street Lift Station No. 9. Both stations, built in the 1980s, are well beyond their design life and have experienced repeated equipment failures and sewage overflows. These upgrades are essential to address aging wastewater infrastructure, increased population demands, and system inflow and infiltration issues.

The project will include the demolition and removal of outdated mechanical and electrical components, and the installation of modern submersible pumps, valves, and controls designed for greater capacity and efficiency. Each lift station will receive new Supervisory Control and Data Acquisition (SCADA) systems, allowing for remote monitoring and improved response during emergencies. The Veterans Drive Lift Station will be reconstructed above the 100-year base flood elevation to protect it from flooding, while the First Street Lift Station will be upgraded from single-phase to three-phase power to improve operational efficiency, reliability, and equipment longevity. Additionally, the project will reroute certain wastewater flows from the Tee Ma Road Lift Station to reduce hydraulic load on the Veterans Drive Lift Station.

Together, these improvements will modernize critical components of the City's wastewater system, reduce the risk of overflows, protect public health and the environment, and ensure reliable, long-term service for the community.

### Why Your Participation Matters

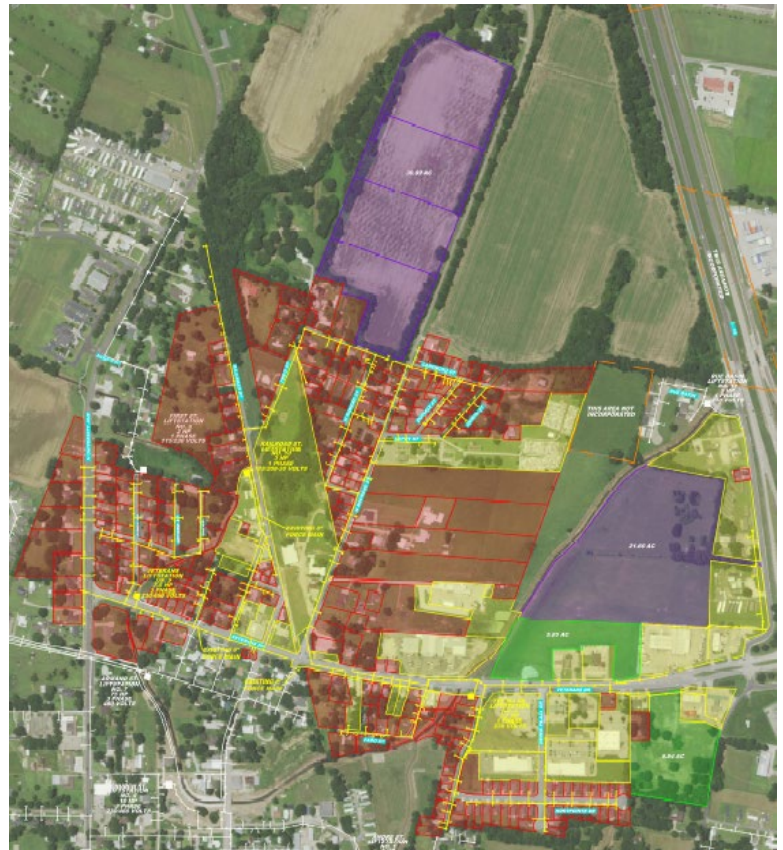
