Mayor Clavier called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Councilmember Antoine Babineaux led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent prayer.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Mayor Clavier informed the council and public that the sewer rate study resulted in no increases for year 2026, the city will revisit in year 2028.

Councilmember Mr. Antoine Babineaux announced that the annual fund raiser for Assumption Church will be held on March 13, 2026 from 5-7pm. Tickets are on sale for the crawfish boil.

GUESTS: Mr. Doyle Boudreaux announced his candidacy for State Representative, District 39, and asked for your continued support.

Councilmember Jordan Arceneaux announced the Carencro Middle School Leaders of the month. The council and public congratulated all students and staff on a job well done.

Gas Supervisor Seth Darbonne- Mr. Purvis Morrison reported that the department completed multiple drainage work orders and multiple land clearing projects on Andre St and Cormier Road.

City Clerk Lisa Meche updated the council and public reporting for the month that the accounting department implemented payrolls for January and accounts payables, human resource maintenance, preparing for the upcoming audit and continued work on the servitudes.

Chief Administrator Officer Purvis Morrison- Working on the drainage master plan with Lamats, Lafayette Tourism Grant close out.

Pelican Park- Michelle Wright updated the council that park held practices every day, summer adult league finals are March 6, tournament on February 28, 2026, Carencro High School Lady Bears begin March 2, 2026.

Carencro Sports Complex Derek Cheramie – men’s soccer league on Monday and Tuesday, men’s flag football on Wednesday, home school physical education on Thursday.

Community Center held 4 events.

Police Chief David Anderson- felony cases are down by 22 percent; crashes have increased by 48 percent.

Fire Chief David Mouton announced his newest full time employee Christian Boutte who comes with nine years of experience from St. Landry Fire District. We are excited to have him serve our community!

CH Fenstermaker Andy Sellers reported that the City-Wide Water Main Rehab Phase 1 bid opening is scheduled for February 26, 2026, Teema Road Sidewalks started today.

Resolution No. 2026-007: A resolution approving the appointment of a director and an alternate director to represent the City of Carencro, State of Louisiana, on the Board of Directors of the Louisiana Municipal Natural Gas Purchasing and Distribution Authority as provided Chapter 10-8 of Title 33 of the Louisiana Revised Statutes of 1950.

Resolution No. 2026-008: A resolution of the Carencro City Council authorizing Mayor Charlotte Clavier to enter into an agreement with Royal Engineers for consultant services for task order projects 1-3.
