Mayor Clavier called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Councilmember Jordan Arceneaux led the Pledge of Allegiance followed by a moment of silent prayer.

ANNOUNCEMENTS: Councilmember Capritto announced the event for Keep Carencro Beautiful will be held on Saturday, April 25, 2026 at 9:00 am at Carencro Park. There is no need to pre-register just show up.

Carencro High School FFA will host its black pot cookoff on Saturday, April 25, 2026.

April 28, 2026 bingo will be held at Carencro Community Center.

Saturday, May 2, 2026 will be the Full Moon Market at City Hall Pavilion.

Thursday, May 7, 2026 will be the National Prayer Day at Carencro Community Center.

Saturday, May 9, 2026 will be the Farmers Market at Carencro Park.

GUESTS: Mr. Kevin Breau with Acadiana Veterans Alliance was presented with a check in the amount of \$2060.00 for the 4th annual Brunch and Beats cookoff proceeds.

Ms. Nicole Girard with the LSU Agriculture Center recognized the kids who placed first in parish or national events. The council and public congratulated all students.

Carencro Middle School Leaders of the Month were announced by Mr. John Harris Assistant Principal of Carencro Middle School. All students and faculty were congratulated by all in attendance.

PROCLAMATION: Carencro High School Principal Vanessa Knott's Retirement was read by Councilmember Jordan Arceneaux. The council and public congratulated her on her retirement and wished her well.

Mayor Clavier announced the vacant position with Lafayette Parish School Board District 2 was filled by Mr. Ted Davidson. Mr. Davidson informed the council and public he would run for this seat with the November 2026 election.

Councilmember Sinegal motioned to adopt the minutes of the regular meeting of the Carencro City Council on March 16, 2026; seconded by Councilmember Arceneaux; motion approved.

Councilmember Capritto made a motion to approve the financial reports; seconded by Councilmember Arceneaux; motion approved.

Mayor Clavier asked for questions or comments from the council or the public regarding the department's monthly reports.

Water Supervisor Buster Broussard- the water department repaired water leaks, installed or replaced water meters, lowered meters for inspections. All lift stations are working

properly. Pelican Point Subdivision installed all water meters, cleaned and video sewer lines. Saddle Creek poured concrete for catch basin tops.

Gas Supervisor Seth Darbonne- completed 11 work orders for streets and drainage completed 2000 linear feet of ditch excavation, repaired potholes, and mulched flower beds at multiple city buildings.

City Clerk Lisa Meche updated the council and public reporting for the month that the accounting department implemented payrolls and accounts payables, human resource maintenance, retrieved documents for the city auditors.

Chief Administrator Officer Purvis Morrison- Absent

Pelican Park- Mike Woodall updated the council that park has booked rentals for 23 weekdays, weekend children's tournaments and 1 adult tournament, yoga class continues at Pelican Park on Monday's at 5:30 pm.

Carencro Sports Complex Mike Woodall – men's soccer league on Monday and Tuesday, men's flag football on Wednesday, home school physical education on Thursday.

Carencro Park- held 2 farmers market, 45 kids for recreational baseball combined with Brown Park.

Community Center held Senior Bingo, Second Harvest Food Drive, Women in Leadership Luncheon.

Police Chief David Anderson- report included in council packets.

Fire Chief David Mouton informed the public that Captain Tyler Coles and Riley Grisham attended a weeklong conference that included hot drills, providing valuable hands-on firefighting training.

CH Fenstermaker Andy Sellers- report included in council packets.

Lynn Guidry City Hall Renovations- Mr. Guidry informed everyone that the bid date is set for June 4, 2026.

RESOLUTIONS:

Resolution No. 2026-017: A resolution of support for improvements along Louisiana Highway 98 (West and East Gloria Switch Road), including restriping, pavement overlay, and other improvements: and providing for other matters related thereto.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-017; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-018: A resolution authorizing the mayor to execute a memorandum of understanding between the City of Carencro, the City of Scott and the Lafayette Parish Registrar of Voters.

There were no votes taken by the Carencro City Council, Therefore Resolution No. 2026-018 failed.

Resolution No. 2026-019: A resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the 2025/2026 utility fund budget by \$100,000.00 for tower lights.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-019; seconded by Councilmember James; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-020: An intergovernmental agreement between the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government and City of Carencro for the Opioid Fund.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-020; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-021: A resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the 2025/2026 2016 Sales Tax Fund by \$85,000.00 for the purchase of two side by sides.

Councilmember Capritto made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-021; seconded by Councilmember Arceneaux; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-022: A resolution for the Lafayette Disability Awareness Committee.

Councilmember Capritto made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-022; seconded by Councilmember Arceneaux; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-023: A resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the 2025/2026 Capital Outlay Fund Budget by \$225,000.00 for the City Hall Renovations/Furnishings from general fund reserves.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-023; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-024: A resolution of the Carencro City Council amending the agreement with Architect Lynn Guidry for the City Hall Renovations.

Councilmember Capritto made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-024; seconded by Councilmember Arceneaux; motion approved.

Resolution No. 2026-025: A resolution authorizing nighttime concrete pouring activities for the sewer plant construction project and providing for related matters.

Mrs. Rebecca Theriot came before the council to voice her concerns regarding the new sewer plant. Mrs. Theriot is requesting a sound wall, 3rd party monitoring and odor controls be in place. Engineer Mr. Chris Richard addressed Mrs. Theriot's concerns in her letter which was submitted to the City of Carencro and mailed to Mrs. Theriot.

Councilmember Sinegal made a motion to approve Resolution No. 2026-025; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

INTRODUCTORY ORDINANCES:

Ordinance No. 2026-004: An ordinance of the City of Carencro to update Chapter 22-Environment to clarify open burning standards associated with land clearing activities.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 2026-004; seconded by Councilmember Sinegal; motion approved.

Ordinance No. 2026-005: An ordinance of the City of Carencro to update Chapter 70-Taxation to clarify Occupational License Standards.

Councilmember Capritto made a motion to introduce Ordinance No. 2026-005; seconded by Councilmember Arceneaux; motion approved.

PUBLIC HEARING:

FINAL ADOPTED ORDINANCES:

Ordinance No. 2026-003: An ordinance of the City of Carencro to annex property located at 338 Thoroughbred Drive, Carencro, Louisiana.

Councilmember Capritto made a motion to final adopt Ordinance No. 2026-003; seconded by Councilmember Sinegal; motion approved.

PUBLIC HEARING:

Preliminary and final plat showing a division of property for plot 3 divided into 3-A, 3-B, 3-C, & 3-D. Plat review No. 3 “A residential development” located in Section 34, T-8-S, R-4-E, estate of Janice & Nicholas Camel (310 Kate Road) Carencro, La. 70520.

Planning Administrator Tammie Robertson gave a review of 310 Kate Road; the purpose of this review is to verify that the plat is in general conformance with the City of Carencro Ordinances. If deficiencies are identified later, the developer will be responsible for correcting identified deficiencies at no cost to the City of Carencro. In summary, I recommend approval of the preliminary and final plat contingent upon the developer satisfying the conditions listed in the City Engineer’s review.

Councilmember Sinegal made a motion to accept preliminary and final plat approval review no. 3 for 310 Kate Road based upon the city engineer’s review; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.

Pelican Pointe (Bechet) Subdivision, a single-family residential development for 73 lots, located in section 34 T8-S-R4-E adjacent to Bois Bechet Subdivision located in 3600 Block of North University to Stemmans Road, City of Carencro, Lafayette Parish, Louisiana, final acceptance review No. 1.

Planning Administrator Tammie Robertson gave a review of Pelican Point; the purpose of this review is to verify that the plat is in general conformance with the City of Carencro Ordinances. If deficiencies are identified later, the developer will be responsible for correcting identified deficiencies at no cost to the City of Carencro. In summary, I recommend approval of the final plat review for Pelican Point (Bechet Road Subdivision) Review No. 1 contingent upon the developer satisfying the conditions listed in the City Engineer’s review.

Councilmember Arceneaux made a motion to accept Pelican Pointe (Bechet) Subdivision 3600 Block of North University to Stemmans Road final acceptance review No. 1; seconded by Councilmember Capritto; motion approved.
